

TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE

BY-LAW #789

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE TO PROVIDE FOR A PENALTY FOR THE CONTRAVENTION OF ANY BY-LAW IN FORCE IN THE TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE

WHEREAS Section 110 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, authorizes a Council of a Municipality to impose a penalty, not exceeding \$2,500.00 exclusive of costs and imprisonment in the case of non-payment of a fine and costs as the case may be, for the contravention of any By-Law.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Town of Beaverlodge, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That any person or persons for contravention of any By-Law in force in the Town of Beaverlodge for which penalty is therein provided shall upon conviction forfeit and pay a penalty not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and costs for each offence and in default of payment thereof it shall be lawful for a tribunal to commit the offender or offenders to imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days unless the said penalty and costs are sooner paid.
2. All fines imposed for the aforesaid shall, unless otherwise provided for, be paid to the Town of Beaverlodge for the benefit of the same.
3. In the case of a conviction for non-payment of any license fee payable to the Town of Beaverlodge under the provisions of any By-Law, the convicting tribunal may adjudge payment thereof in addition to any penalty provided for under this By-Law.
4. By-Law no. 664 is hereby repealed.
5. This By-Law shall take effect on the final day of passing thereof.
