## TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE

## BY-LAW #789

## IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE TO PROVIDE FOR A PENALTY FOR THE CONTRAVENTION OF ANY BY-LAW IN FORCE IN THE TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE

WHEREAS Section 110 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, authorizes a Council of a Municipality to impose a penalty, not exceeding \$2,500.00 exclusive of costs and imprisonment in the case of non-payment of a fine and costs as the case may be, for the contravention of any By-Law.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Town of Beaverlodge, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. That any person or persons for contravention of any By-Law in force in the Town of Beaverlodge for which penalty is therein provided shall upon conviction forfeit and pay a penalty not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and costs for each offence and in default of payment thereof it shall be lawful for a tribunal to commit the offender or offenders to imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days unless the said penalty and costs are sooner paid.
- 2. All fines imposed for the aforesaid shall, unless otherwise provided for, be paid to the Town of Beaverlodge for the benefit of the same.
- 3. In the case of a conviction for non-payment of any license fee payable to the Town of Beaverlodge under the provisions of any By-Law, the convicting tribunal may adjudge payment thereof in addition to any penalty provided for under this By-Law.
- 4. By-Law no. 664 is hereby repealed.
- 5. This By-Law shall take effect on the final day of passing thereof.
