2021 PROPERTY ASSESSMENT & TAX NOTICE

The Town of Beaverlodge Property Assessment and Tax Notices were mailed on May 28, 2021. Property Taxes are normally due July 31, 2021, and residents/businesses are encouraged to pay their property taxes by this date.

Due to challenges stemming from COVID-19, Council passed a motion to defer the Tax deadline to Cotober 31, 2021, for any residents/businesses who are experiencing hardships. For residents/businesses to take advantage of this deferral, they must make application to the Town. To make an application, please visit our website at www.beaverlodge.ca – For Residents – Property Taxes.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Failure to receive a tax notice is not considered sufficient reason for nonpayment of taxes.

For those that do not apply for the deferral a penalty of 12% will be applied August 1, 2021 on any outstanding current taxes excepting those associated

with the Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP).

For those that apply for the deferral a penalty of 12% will be applied November 1, 2021 on any outstanding current taxes.

Residents and businesses are encouraged to pay their property taxes by the original deadline of July 31, 2021 if possible.

Payment options have been expanded for the 2021 tax year. Property owners can choose to enroll in a Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) and divide their tax payments into six monthly payments throughout 2021; or make an initial six-month lump sum payment and pay the remaining balance is six monthly payments. To register for either option, property owners must enroll by June 30, 2021. To enroll contact the town office at 780-354-2201 or email taxes@beaverlodge.ca to discuss your options.

PREPARATION OF 2021 ASSESSMENT ROLL

Notice is hereby given that the Assessment Roll of the Town of Beaverlodge, made under the provision of the Municipal Government Act, Statues of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-25.1, has been prepared. The roll will be open for inspection at the Town Office from 9:00 am to 12:00 (noon), then 1:00pm to 5:00pm Monday through Friday, excepting statutory holidays. Please call the office at 780-354-2201 to make an appointment as COVID restrictions may be in place.

Any person who objects to the name, assessed values or the mill rate classification as entered on the assessment roll must lodge a complaint in writing, accompanied by a \$50.00 fee to the Deputy CAO at the Town Office by 4pm, Friday, August 6, 2021.

The assessment and taxation notices were mailed on May 28, 2021.

Bronze Medallion

Prerequisites: Bronze Star or 13 yrs. or older

Course Cost: \$170

Bronze medallion teaches four components of water rescue education: judgement, knowledge, skills, and fitness. Rescuers learn tows, carries, and defense and release methods in preparation for challenging rescues of conscious and Unconscious victims. Includes CPR A and AED.

Course Cost: \$125

Prerequisites: Bronze Medallion and Emergency First Aid or Standard First Aid certifications (need not be current). Designed for lifesavers who want the challenge of more advanced training including an introduction to safe supervision in aquatic facilities. Bronze Cross is a prerequisite for all advanced training programs including National Lifeguard and Instructor certification. Includes a timed 600 m swim.

National Lifeguard

Course Cost: \$395

Prerequisites: Must be a minimum of 16 years old, Bronze Cross certification and standard first aid. The National Lifeguard certification is the standard measurement of lifeguard performance in Canada The course is designed to develop sound understanding of lifeguarding principles, good judgement and a mature responsible attitude toward the role of lifeguard. The program emphasizes teamwork, leadership, communications and the prevention of accidents and the treatment of medical emergencies.



This assessment is being done so we can understand what valves/manholes need to be fixed in the coming years.

DID YOU KNOW...

Water Conservation By-Law #885

The Town of Beaverlodge has a water conservation by-law in place. This is very important as it helps us to conserve and protect our water supply, while still allowing residents to water their lawns and keep them looking beautiful.

Normal watering days for odd numbered houses are Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday and for even numbered houses Monday, Wednesday and Saturday. Watering may only be done during the following hours: 6-9 a.m. and 7-11 p.m. Flowerbeds and vegetable gardens may be watered by hand, at any time, using a watering can or a hose with a nozzle with a trigger shut off to restrict water flow. Children's water toys may be used for recreational purposes as long as the children are present.

These are level 1 restrictions and fines can be levied if they are not adhered to.
