

ROAD/TOWN IMPROVEMENTS

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE HAS GIVEN FIRST READING TO BYLAW NO. 1004, LAND USE BYLAW.



The purpose of the bylaw is to repeal Bylaw 860 and replace it with a new land use bylaw. The new bylaw updates several sections of the Land Use Bylaw to improve the administrative aspects of the bylaw, to add uses to the industrial district to improve competitiveness, to add some Direct Control districts to provide flexibility to Council to make decisions on unique developments and to make the bylaw consistent with recent changes to the MGA. A copy of the proposed Land Use Bylaw may be inspected by the public on our website at beaverlodge.ca or at the Town Office during normal business hours.

A public hearing will be held in Council Chambers on August 9, 2021 at approximately 7 p.m. Any person wishing to appear before council may attend the hearing and have their submission heard. Written submissions may be submitted to the Town Office no later than 4:00 PM Friday August 6, 2021.
