

BY-LAW #746

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH A LOCAL UNIT AUTHORITY AND AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO PROVIDE FAMILY AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES FOR THE TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE.

WHEREAS: Section 2 of the Family and Community Support Services Act, Chapter F,-1.1, 1989, determines that a Municipality may provide for the establishment, administration and operation of a Family and Community Support Services program within the Municipality, and

WHEREAS: The Minister of Community & Occupational Health has given his consent to the Town of Beaverlodge to establish its own local separate Unit Authority to provide Family & Community Support Service within the Town of Beaverlodge, and

WHEREAS: Section 3.(3) of the Family & Community Support Service Act states that where a Municipality provides for the establishment, administration and operation of a program in a manner that is satisfactory to the Minister, the Minister may pay the Municipality an amount not exceeding 80% of the cost of the program, and

WHEREAS: The Council of the Town of Beaverlodge recognizes the need for a Local "Advisory Committee" to assist and advise in the operation of Family & Community Support Services programs.


NOW THEREFORE: The Municipal Council of the Town of Beaverlodge, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled hereby enact the following:

1. This By-Law shall be known as the "Family & Community Support Services By-Law.
2. This By-Law recognizes the elected Council of the Town of Beaverlodge as the "Family & Community Support Services Board".
3. This By-Law recognizes the need and shall appoint two elected and three members at large as members of a Family & Community Support Services "Advisory Committee".
4. The "Terms of Office" for the members of the "Advisory Committee" shall be as follows:
 - 4.1 The "elected" representatives of the Council of the Town of Beaverlodge shall be those members appointed annually to the Town of Beaverlodge "Protective Services Committee".
 - 4.2 The "appointed" representatives shall be appointed for a one-year term of office, which may be renewable to a three-year term. After serving a three-year term of office, the appointed member shall resign, but may be reappointed after a one-year mandatory break.
 - 4.3 The Terms of Office of an appointed member shall be terminated if three consecutive meetings are missed.
 - 4.4 The "Advisory Committee" shall, at their annual organizational meeting, appoint a Chairperson, who shall be appointed for a one-year term, and may be reappointed for two consecutive one-year terms.
5. The duties and responsibilities of the "Advisory Committee" shall be determined as follows:
 - 5.1 To receive preventative project proposals and budgets for programs, whose point of origin is in the Town of Beaverlodge.
 - 5.2 "Preventative Programs" shall mean those programs so defined in Section 1 and 2 of the Family & Community Support Services regulations, and attached to this By-Law as Annex "A".
 - 5.3 Meetings to be held at the call of the chair for the purpose of prioritizing these submissions and proposals for presentation to the Family & Community Support Services Board" for final approval and implementation and to monitor these projects which best reflect the social needs within the Municipality.


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- 5.4 To perform other duties as requested by the "Board" from time to time, which reflect or enhance the preventative nature of Family & Community Support Services.
- 6. This By-Law replaces any related By-Law previously established, i.e. Family & Community Support Services By-Law No. 672.
- 7. This By-Law becomes effective upon the date of final passing thereof.
