

COUNTY'S ANNUAL PROPERTY INSPECTION

A reminder to please complete the re-inspection notices that were recently mailed out to all property owners. The County of Grande Prairie has always been the Town's assessor. Every 5 years the County assesses properties to determine their estimated market value, which is used to calculate property taxes. Historically, these assessments have be done in-person and can still be done so upon request, as well as for those residents that do not complete the Request for Information. The deadline for property owners to complete the Requests for Information is May 1, 2022.
