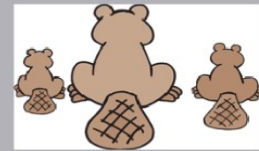

## Council Update

This has been a busy year a number of projects started some finished some still in progress. Infrastructure was and still is a target with over thirty valves repaired, Fourth Avenue rebuilt, final stages of a nearly eleven million dollar water treatment plant update will be completed in the Spring. Infrastructure will be a long term project with water, sewage and street repairs. Firehall replacement is well under way although a few weeks behind it is looking good for Spring opening.

The Beaverlodge community bus that should have arrived in December has been delayed until the new year because of a missing seat, that should happen soon.

Recreation is also a target , studies of the facilities and their conditions, arena, parks, walking trails, ball diamonds, and playing fields should be done soon so a master plan can be developed.

Health care of course has been one of the most important subjects this month.

Alberta Health Services has signed a letter of intent to be the main tenant for the hospital replacement with the Town of Beaverlodge and Landrex corporation a P3 project. 2022 has been a busy and exciting year. We can't touch on all the work our staff has completed, but we are extremely proud of them.

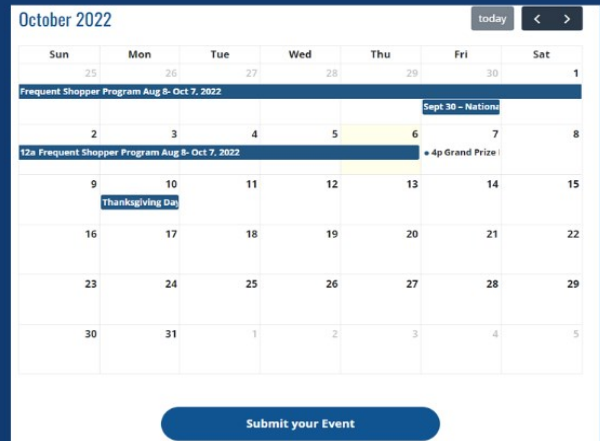
