


Beaverlodge has grown over the past decade with several industries; agriculture, forestry, and oil and gas sectors contributing to the town's prosperity. The economic diversity, high quality health and wellness, education and recreation make Beaverlodge a great place to visit or settle down and grow roots.

The town boasts an indoor pool and fitness center which includes a main pool, leisure pool, lazy river, whirl pool and fully equipped gym. There is also an ice arena, curling rink, agricultural barns, tennis courts, ball diamonds, bike park, several playgrounds, and the scenic Pioneer Campground. While visiting, check out the Beaverlodge Cultural Centre which features local artists on a rotating basis and a beautiful Tea Room to enjoy lunch. Opposite the building, visitors can view the magnificent roadside attraction: The World's Largest Beaver, 17' tall by 28' long and weighing 3000 pounds.

West of Beaverlodge is the South Peace Centennial Museum the largest – and only working – steam powered farm equipment museum in Alberta. Plan your trip around "Pioneer Days", the third Sunday in July. This special event is the only weekend where the equipment comes alive to demonstrate the days of old, along with an antique car and truck show.

To the east of Beaverlodge is Saskatoon Island Provincial Park, a wildlife refuge for the Trumpeter Swan. The park has amazing views, accessible by the many walking trails. It is home to a variety of plants, animals, forest, grassland and lakeside birds. Popular for bird watching!

Don't forget to visit our local farmers' market for fresh produce, and a unique shopping experience in the downtown area. There is a variety of eating establishments and general stores with something for everyone!


