·Stay Informed and Prepared:

Alarms - 1

- Stay updated on local weather and fire conditions through reliable sources.
- Have a fire emergency plan in place for your household and ensure everyone knows how to respond in case of a fire.
- Keep fire extinguishers in accessible areas of your home and know how to use them effectively.

Be Cautious with Campfires:

- Follow local regulations and guidelines for campfire safety.
- Choose a safe location for the campfire away from overhanging branches, dry grass, or other flammable materials.
- Keep the campfire small and manageable, and never leave it unattended.
- Completely extinguish the campfire before leaving the area or going to sleep.

<u>Practice Safe</u> <u>Outdoor Cooking:</u>

- Use grills, barbecues, and outdoor cooking appliances in a safe and designated area away from flammable materials.
- Keep a close eye on the grill or cooking area and never leave it unattended.
- Ensure proper disposal of charcoal and ashes in a metal container, allowing them to cool completely before disposal.
