

Council Approves New Community Bus Policy: What that Means for Residents

The Town of Beaverlodge Council has announced a new bus policy, set to take effect on September 1st, 2024, marking a significant update from the previous policy established in November 2018. This change comes following the purchase of a new community bus in 2023, designed to enhance transportation services for residents.

One of the notable updates in the new policy is the revised fee for the Wednesday Grande Prairie run. The fare for a round trip to Grande Prairie and back to Beaverlodge will now be \$10. Residents must still make an appointment to ride the bus by calling 780-354-4057 no later than 4 PM on the preceding Tuesday. It is important to note that the bus service will be cancelled if fewer than six riders are registered.

When booking appointments in Grande Prairie, riders are advised to schedule between 11 AM and 1 PM. This scheduling window ensures that the bus can transport passengers to their destinations and back home efficiently.

Additionally, the rates for privately booking the Community Bus have been updated. For detailed information on the new rates and booking procedures, residents are advised to contact the FCSS office directly.

These changes reflect the Town's commitment to providing reliable and convenient transportation options for its residents.

Swimming Lesson/Fitness Class Refund Policy:

Refunds will be provided under the following conditions only: When a doctor's note is provided the refund is effective starting the date the doctor's note is received by the recreation staff; or if the program is cancelled by the Town. Credit will be issued for the unused portion of a program under the following conditions: When notice is provided by the facility or program operator seven (7) days prior to the start of the program; or when there is a waitlist and staff are unable to resell the space in that program; or if the program is rescheduled by the Town. Transfers are permitted when the recreation staff are notified seven (7) days prior to the course or program start date or at the recommendation of the instructor provided the course or program has not already started. All refunds/transfers will be subject to a \$10 administration fee, unless altered by the Town Office.
