

Grand Opening of the New Beaverlodge Fire Hall

The Town of Beaverlodge celebrated the grand opening of its new fire hall on November 2, 2024. This modern facility is the result of a successful collaboration between the Town of Beaverlodge, the County of Grande Prairie, and the Beaverlodge Firefighters Association.

Construction began in May 2022 and was completed in September 2023, marking a significant upgrade from the previous fire hall, which served the community for 42 years. Firefighters officially moved into the new building on October 16, 2023.

The grand opening event drew community members and representatives from all three partnering organizations. Attendees enjoyed guided tours of the state-of-the-art facility, showcasing its improved capacity to support emergency services. Hot dogs and cake added to the celebratory atmosphere.

The former fire hall has been repurposed and now houses Public Works and the town community bus, ensuring its continued service to Beaverlodge residents. This milestone represents a bright future for fire and emergency services in Beaverlodge and the surrounding area.

AHS Announces 24/7 Urgent Care Model

The new Mountview Health Complex will maintain the same level of health care access for Beaverlodge and surrounding communities with 24-7 urgent care services. Alberta's government is investing \$25.2 million to replace the 68-year-old Beaverlodge Health Centre with a state-of-the-art facility, which will also include 32 inpatient beds, lab services, imaging, and rehabilitation care.

The facility will be built on 20 acres generously donated by the late Doris McFarlane, a long-time community advocate and former nurse. Expected to open in 2028, the complex reflects community feedback and incorporates culturally responsive practices, ensuring inclusivity for Indigenous populations. A town hall meeting is scheduled for December 4 at 6pm at the Beaverlodge Community Centre to provide project updates.

This investment promises to support the health needs of future generations, bridging gaps in care and keeping services close to home.
