TIME TO RENEW YOUR PET & BUSINESS LICENSES

All dogs and cats within the Town of Beaverlodge must be licensed. Licenses are valid for the calendar year only. Existing licenses will expire December 31, 2024. Licenses for 2025 must be purchased by January 31, 2025.

BUSINESS LICENSES: All businesses require a license in Beaverlodge. Existing Business Licenses will expire December 31, 2024. 2025 licenses must be purchased before January 31, 2025.
