

TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Council of the Town of Beaverlodge has given first reading to Bylaw No. 1034, being a textual amendment to the Land Use Bylaw No. 1004.

The purpose of the bylaw is to add the following definitions:

- · "Accessory Dwelling"
- "Garage Suite"
- · "Self-Storage Facility"

Further to add the following to Section 9 General Regulations:

- 9.23 Accessory Dwelling
- 9.24 Garage Suite

Further to add the following uses to Discretionary Uses in the following zones:

11.1.2 (b) Discretionary Uses to include:

- · Accessory Dwelling
- · Garage Suite
- · Basement Suite

11.3.2 (b) Discretionary Uses to include:

- Accessory Dwelling
- Garage Suite
- Basement Suite

11.4.2 (b) Discretionary Uses to include:

- · Accessory Dwelling
- · Garage Suite
- · Basement Suite

11.7.2 (b) Discretionary Uses to include:

- · Self-Storage Facility
- · Child Care Facility

This amendment is being proposed to meet the community's changing needs, to foster a prosperous local economy, and to grow in a responsible manner for years to come.

A copy of the proposed Land Use Bylaw Amendment may be inspected by the public on our website at www.beaverlodge.ca or at the Town Office during normal business hours.

A public hearing will be held in Council Chambers on May 12, 2025 at approximately 6 p.m. Any person wishing to appear before Council may attend the hearing and have their submission heard. Written submissions may be submitted to the Town Office no later than 4:00 PM Wednesday May 7, 2025 or they can be submitted via email to development@beaverlodge.ca
