Christmas Craze Brings Christmas Joy



The holidays are here again, and you can feel the community spirit shining in every corner of Beaverlodge. This time of year reminds us how fortunate we are to live in a small town where people truly know and care for one another, and where pride in our community runs deep.

Once again, our local volunteers and organizations have made the season bright. The light displays at the campground and at the South Peace Centennial Museum are outstanding, turning our long winter nights into something magical. The Chamber of Commerce has outdone itself with their beautiful tree and another successful Christmas Craze. Thank you to everyone who gave their time, energy, and creativity to make these events happen — this kind of dedication is exactly what defines a strong, close-knit community.

This is also a time to look back on all we've accomplished together over the past year. Our sidewalk program is well under way, improving safety and walkability for residents of all ages. The pool change room renovations and boiler upgrades are complete, helping us better serve families and swimmers. At the arena, kitchen upgrades and improvements to the security system are finished as well, supporting both user groups and community events. Important capital projects are also moving ahead, including the lagoon design upgrade and the sanitary main design — quiet but critical work that keeps our town running smoothly now and into the future.

We've also seen exciting progress on the Mountview Health Complex in 2025. Premier Danielle Smith joined us for the sod turning in May, we broke ground and began moving dirt in July, and concrete work started in October. If all continues as planned, we expect to see steel standing before the end of January 2026. This project represents not only improved health services, but also our shared commitment to the long-term well-being of Beaverlodge and the region.

We have so much to be thankful for, and so much to look forward to. Our greatest strength has always been our people — neighbours helping neighbours, volunteers stepping up, businesses supporting local events, and families choosing to call Beaverlodge home. Together, we continue to build a community we can all be proud of.

Everyone has emotions—just like everyone has thoughts. And while we're often taught to label some feelings as "bad" or "too much," emotions aren't the enemy. They're your body's built-in alarm system, letting you know when something matters, when something hurts, when something needs attention.

In this teen mask-painting session, we'll explore the feelings we show to the world...and the ones we keep tucked away. Using a mask as our canvas, teens will create two sides: the "outside face" people usually see, and the "inside face" that holds what's often hidden.
