30 amp power sites include: 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 12, 13, and 14

15 amp power sites include: 20—29

Tent sites include: 1-7 on the grass

We have free Wi-Fi for anyone staying in the campground.

Bathrooms, showers, sewer dump and potable water are also included with your stay.

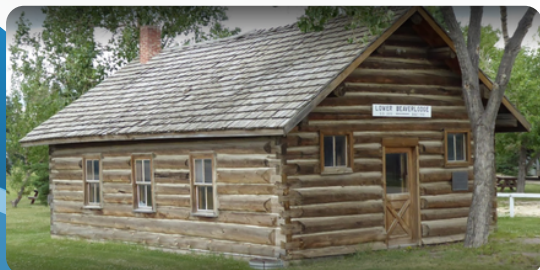
Firewood can be purchased for \$5/wheelbarrow.

Please visit the Historical Site of the Lower Beaverlodge School that was in use from 1912 to 1947. It was constructed in 1912 and moved and restored in 1986. It is dedicated to the pioneers of the Lower Beaverlodge and District. For a time, the school served as a tourist information booth until the Visitors Information Centre opened at the Beaverlodge Cultural Centre, next to the Giant Beaver monument.



RULES OF CONDUCT

- All campers must register upon arrival
- Please camp, picnic and drive in designated areas.
- Quiet hours are from 11pm to 7am.
- Please respect your neighbors' area. Do Not Walk Through Campsites.
- All pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Your pets waste must be picked up and placed in the garbage bin.
- Tidiness of the campsites is mandatory.
- Your garbage must be taken to the bin prior to your leaving. Do not leave garbage at the site, anyone doing so may be banned from staying at the campground again.
- No clothes lines.
- Empty beverage containers can be left for recycling in the bin provided by the washrooms.
- Checkout time is 12:00 Noon.
- Dogs must be on a leash & cleaned up after.
- Fires in designated firepits only—check Alberta Wildfire regulations if unsure.
- Please notify park host of any facility issues.

Note: The Beaverlodge Pioneer Campground is maintained and managed by the Town of Beaverlodge. The Town reserves the right to refuse and/or evict occupants of this facility if found to be contravening any of the rules and regulations.
